2.Review of Minutes

Review of minutes (end of the year report) by Mrs. Erdmann. Enrollment is currently at 616 over the projected 600. Mrs. Morantes has been hired as a 4/5 split teacher. Concern was made over how parents were informed. Next time we acquire new staff a notice will be sent out to all parents and effected parents at the same time. Contact will be made with parents first. There is a goal for the district to go wireless. Mrs. Fitzgerald's focus is going to be technology. The customer satisfaction survey was reviewed. There was not a great turn out and some questions are confusing. There was a trend in the district that parents saw the schools as safer than the children did.

Mrs. Tibbs introduced tutor.com to the board. Students and military dependents can use this valuable program for free. There will be a link added to the school website about the program.

Mr.DeLong informed us of a program(the military child education coalition) on Wednesday October 19th at the Bamberg High School, located in the multi-purpose room. The program will be on charting a course for success after high school. Also, he is looking into bringing the Living in the new normal workshop to Bamberg in the spring. It could possibly be on a Saturday if there is a good response. He discussed the Interstate compact that effects military children moving from state to state and overseas to states.
